Isaiah 11:11 NIV

11 In that day the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to reclaim the remnant that is left of his people from Assyria, from Lower Egypt, from Upper Egypt, from Cush, from Elam, from Babylonia, from Hamath and from the islands of the sea.

Isaiah 24:15 NIV

15 Therefore in the east give glory to the Lord; exalt the name of the Lord, the God of Israel, in the islands of the sea.

Isaiah 41:1 KJV

41:1 Keep silence before me, O islands ; and let the people renew their strength: let them come near; then let them speak: let us come near together to judgment.

Isaiah 41:4-5 NIV

4 Who has done this and carried it through, calling forth the generations from the beginning? I, the Lord — with the first of them and with the last — I am he." 5 The islands have seen it and fear; the ends of the earth tremble.

Isaiah 42:4 NIV

4 he will not falter or be discouraged till he establishes justice on earth. In his law the islands will put their hope."

Isaiah 42:12-13 NIV

12 Let them give glory to the Lord and proclaim his praise in the islands. 13 The Lord will march out like a mighty man, like a warrior he will stir up his zeal; with a shout he will raise the battle cry and will triumph over his enemies.

Isaiah 51:5 AMP

My rightness and justice are near, My salvation is going forth, and My arms shall rule the peoples; the islands shall wait for and expect Me, and on My arm shall they trust and wait with hope.

Isaiah 60:9 NIV

9 Surely the islands look to me; in the lead are the ships of Tarshish, bringing your sons from afar, with their silver and gold, to the honor of the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has endowed you with splendor.

Isaiah 42:10 NIV

10 Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise from the ends of the earth, you who go down to the sea, and all that is in it, you islands , and all who live in them.

Isaiah 49:1-3 NIV

Listen to me, you islands ; hear this, you distant nations: Before I was born the Lord called me; from my birth he has made mention of my name. 2 He made my mouth like a sharpened sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me into a polished arrow and concealed me in his quiver. 3 He said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor."

Isaiah 66:19 NIV

19 "I will set a sign among them, and I will send some of those who survive to the nations — to Tarshish, to the Libyans and Lydians (famous as archers), to Tubal and Greece, and to the distant islands that have not heard of my fame or seen my glory. They will proclaim my glory among the nations.

Psalms 97:1 TLB

Jehovah is King! Let all the earth rejoice! Tell the farthest islands to be glad.

Isaiah 61:7 NIV

Instead of their shame my people will receive a double portion, and instead of disgrace they will rejoice in their inheritance; and so they will inherit a double portion in their land, and everlasting joy will be theirs.
